

Rules for Participation in the e-Close Project Closing Conference
entitled
HOW TO BRING STUDENTS CLOSER TO PROACTIVE TEACHERS
AFTER COVID OUTBREAK

§ 1
General provisions

- 1.1. „The Conference HOW TO BRING STUDENTS CLOSER TO PROACTIVE TEACHERS AFTER COVID OUTBREAK”, hereinafter referred to as the Conference, is an event summarizing the Project entitled: “A model for Interactive (A)Synchronous Learning in Online STEM Education” e-CLOSE financed by the programme Erasmus+ Strategic Partnerships for Digital Education in the Higher Education Sector, held at Lodz University of Technology.
- 1.2. The Conference is organized by the International Cooperation Centre of Lodz University of Technology, having its seat in Łódź, at Żwirki 36 street, postal code 90-539, hereinafter referred to as the 'Organiser'.
- 1.3. The Conference will be held on 27th February 2023 in Łódź, in the building of the International Cooperation Centre TUL, at Żwirki 36 street, 90-539.

- 1.6. The Organizer reserves the right to make changes to the Conference Agenda and the Conference Rules, while making a commitment to publish these changes on the Project website.

§ 2
Participation in the Conference

- 2.1. The Participant of the Conference, hereinafter referred to as the "Participant", may be an employee of a Polish or foreign higher education institution, as well as a representative of a company or other organization, hereinafter referred to as the "Institution" who satisfies all conditions of participation referred to in this section.
- 2.2. In order to participate in the Conference, a Participant is required to register via the registration form available on the website: <https://forms.office.com/e/e8n7qh1At3>
- 2.3. The Conference is a closed event, only persons who have previously registered may attend.

- 2.4. The number of places at the Conference is limited.
- 2.5. Late registration will be possible subject to availability of places.
- 2.6. The Organizer reserves the right to close the registration before the scheduled date specified on the Project website.
- 2.7. The Organizer is not responsible for incorrect or false data provided by the Participant during the registration process.
- 2.8. Registration means acceptance of the provisions of these Rules and the need to comply with the law and any other arrangements made between the Participant and the Organizer.
- 2.9. The language of the Conference is English.

§ 3

Resignation of a Participant

§ 4

Force majeure. Cancellation of an event

- 4.1. Force majeure shall mean a sudden external event, independent of the Organizer, making it impossible to fulfil the obligation in whole or in the declared manner and scope, impossible to foresee and prevent. Such an event shall include in particular wars, natural disasters, strikes and acts of governmental and administration authorities – e.g. announcement of national mourning.
- 4.2. In cases beyond the control of the Organizer, due to force majeure, the Organizer may decide to cancel or change the date of the Conference.

§ 5

Final provisions

- 5.1. The Organizer reserves the right to audiovisual and photographic recording of the Conference. Persons making recordings and taking photographs are bound to the Organizer by a legal relationship, which includes the disposal of photographs taken by them.

- 5.2. Each Participant grants the Organizer the irrevocable and gratuitous right for unlimited use of photographs and recordings of their image made during the Conference, without the need to receive consent each time. The consent includes, in particular, the use, recording, processing and reproduction of photographs and recordings made with any medium, exclusively for promotional and archival purposes of the Conference.
- 5.3. All materials made available to the Participant of the Conference are protected under the provisions of copyright and related rights, and therefore may not be used by the Participant for commercial purposes.
- 5.4. During the registration referred to in § 2(2.2) of these Rules, each Participant of the Conference will be required to grant Lodz University of Technology the consent to process their personal data.
- 5.5. All disputes that may arise from participation in the Conference will be settled by a court of competent jurisdiction of the Organizer.
- 5.6. In matters not governed by these Rules, the provisions of the Polish Civil Code will apply.
- 5.7. The Organizer shall not be liable for Participants' belongings which may be lost, damaged or stolen during the Conference.
- 5.8. Participants are fully liable for damage caused by them on the premises where any activities related to the Conference are held.
- 5.9. These Rules shall enter into force on the date of their publication on the Project website.
